## **Site Selection Process**



## **Central Massachusetts Regional Brownfields Assessment Program**

- 1. Proponent submits completed Nomination Form.
  - a. Assistance with the form is available from CMRPC staff/contractor.
  - b. Nominations are accepted on a rolling basis.
- 2. Nominations are reviewed internally by CMRPC staff/contractor for completeness and apparent site eligibility; follow-up information may be requested from the proponent. For projects that are apparently eligible, the contractor develops a preliminary scope of work and cost estimate.
- 3. Nominations are discussed by CMRPC's Brownfields Advisory Committee at its appx. quarterly meetings to review project benefits and feasibility. Proponents are encouraged to attend to discuss their projects.
  - a. Selection factors include:
    - Project location with regard to CMRPC Regional Brownfields Plan's Areas of Brownfields Interest, Environmental Justice areas, access to existing infrastructure, and access to transit
    - ii. Proposed reuse benefits such as affordable housing, economic development and job creation, and quality of life and health/environmental benefits. Timing, viability and readiness are considered but are less important for sites seeking Phase I assistance only.
    - iii. Alignment with community needs and priorities
    - iv. Alignment with EPA and CMPRC program goals and requirements
    - v. Community support
- 4. A Site Eligibility Form is completed by CMRPC staff/contractor and sent to EPA or MassDEP as appropriate for a formal determination of eligibility for use of site assessment funds.
- 5. CMRPC staff makes the final site selection decision

Following selection of a site, a final scope of work is developed by CMRPC's contractor and (if not yet completed) a site access agreement must be executed.
