



Route 146 Corridor Vision Study Public Meeting #1

What is happening?

MassDOT will hold a Public Information Meeting for the Route 146 Corridor Vision Study on December 11, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., virtually.

At this meeting, the study team will provide an overview of the scope of work and study background. Attendees will then be organized into groups to rotate between interactive stations to learn about existing conditions and a preliminary assessment of issues and opportunities within the study area. Accessibility accommodations and language services will be provided free of charge, upon request, as available.

The purpose of the Route 146 Corridor Vision Study is to evaluate different ways to approach expected congestion and safety-related challenges through capital and operational investments. The Study will utilize land use and transportation data to identify when proposed or planned development would require various capital improvements, and to examine and analyze potential transportation alternatives.
