Project Location

Sturbridge -Route

Existing Conditions

- The speed limit in this section of Rt. 20 is 50MPH.
- There was a 2017-2019 HSIP crash cluster in this area.
- Recent commercial growth in the area has increased the number of left hand turns therefore increasing the potential for serious crashes

Regional Significance


- Route 20 is an Urban Principal Arterial and part of the NHS-MAP21.
- Route 20 is a major East/West corridor in the region
- The Average Daily Traffic (ADT) is 24,000.

Project Need and Area Goals

- It is the long-term goal of the District to median divide Route 20 and provide strategic locations for vehicles to reverse direction.
- The potential improvements for this project include a median along Route 20, with a roundabout at Hall Rd to allow vehicles to reverse direction without having to make left turn maneuvers.
- Access for the properties east of Hall Rd will also be investigated for potential safety improvements to their access points.
- This project will significantly improve safety at Hall Rd and at the driveways along the corridor.

Project Status

- Project is currently at the Pre-25% design stage.
- Survey has been completed.
- A design consultant has been assigned .
- The required environmental permits are still being determined.
- ROW acquisitions or easements are still being determined.
- Some utility relocations will be required.
- Current cost estimate is \$ 6,579,155.
